Travel information to Lund

By airplane:

More information about the two main airports in the region can be found below:

1. Copenhagen Airport (CPH) - Kastrup

The closest large international airport is Copenhagen airport (CPH), also called Kastrup, in Denmark:

Travel from CPH to Lund is easiest by train. Travel information of the regional company can be found on the link below. You can enter Kastrup and Lund C in their English travel planner. At Copenhagen airport you can either buy a ticket from a Skånetrafiken ticket machine or from the Danish provider DSB either by machine or over the desk. A train ticket is around 11 Euro. There are even ticket machines in the luggage hall, but most of them are located near the train station close to the check-in area from SAS.

Taxis are also available between CPH and Lund, but always agree on the price before you enter a taxi. It is recommended to take a Swedish taxi and to pre-book as there is a toll fee on bridge between Kastrup airport and Sweden and you might have to pay that twice. Prices are at least 100 Euro. If you want you can pre-book taxis you may use one of the following numbers:

2. Malmö Airport (MMX)

The closest local airport is Malmö Airport (MMX), also called Sturup, in Sweden:

Travel from MMX to Lund is easiest by airport bus (flygbussarna). The bus trip takes 35 minutes and the cost is around 10 Euro. The station closest to Elite Hotel Ideon is called Ideon Gammahuset (or simply Ideon), but the buss also continues to the city centre. Tickets can be bought on the bus using a credit card (most cards are accepted), but it is not possible to pay with cash. More information about the airport buss can be found at:

It is also possible to take a taxi from MMX to Lund. The cost of a taxi is approximately 50 Euro. If you want you can pre-book taxis you may use one of the following numbers:

Taxi Lund: + 46(0) 46-12 12 12

By train:

From Scandinavia and Northern Continental Europe it is also possible to take the train to Lund (called Lund C, Lund Central or Lund Central Station). There are several possible operators. Deutsche Bahn is one option:

Travel information in Lund

Lund has a good network of busses that connect most part of the city. The station closest to the Elite Hotel Ideon is called Lund Ideon. Busses 166 and 169 (yellow busses) or bus 21 and 20 (green busses) can be taken from the Lund Ideon stop to the city centre. You can plan your trip on the city busses using the following web page:
